

Liv Privacy Policy

Information is collected on this website by Liv Global LLC (the "Company"). The Company is committed to protecting your privacy and will use your personal information responsibly. Please read below for detailed information about our privacy policy (the "Policy").

Information Collection and Use

The Company is the owner of all information collected at this site. We will not share or rent this personal information with or to anyone else in any way that is different from what is disclosed to you in this Policy. We may collect information from several different points on our website or the websites of the Company's Promoters, when you make a purchase from one of our Promoters or have other interactions where personal data is provided.

At certain points in interactive communication with us, you might provide us with personal information such as your name, address, telephone number, and email address. Demographic personal information such as income level, gender, and other personal information of yours may be provided by you on an optional basis.

We may also gather on-line information regarding your purchases and shopping activities on websites we host (such as those of Promoters) to improve the content, ease of use and shopping experience on those websites and to improve our marketing and promotions for our company overall and the websites in particular.

In addition, our web server may automatically collect the following non-personally identifiable information:

- your internet service provider's address;
- the referring URL; and
- the information on the pages you access on our site or on the sites of the Promoters since we host those websites

Personal information that you provide to the Company will be used by us for the purposes of enabling a Promoter to contact you at your request for the purposes of your becoming a Promoter. The Company may also use your personal information to contact you to keep you informed of developments or opportunities in relation to the Company, or any of its products or services.

We may also use information collected when you make a purchase on-line through a Promoter website or at a Company program/event in order to process your order or purchase, process credit card payments, provide warranty service, or advise you of promotions and Company product news or events. We may also send you emails with offers from marketing partners which have products or services we believe might be of interest to you.

We use third party companies to gather information and provide services to us including, for example, in maintaining and organizing customer and member information and conducting promotions, upgrading our internet services, sending communications, and contacting our customers and members. Some of those third parties will and do have access to the information which customers provide, including email addresses and credit card information and they may also use cookies on behalf of the Company.

We may also use third party providers to provide ads for the Company's products or services throughout the internet. They may provide anonymous information regarding your visits to a Company website (or that of a Promoter) and your interaction with the goods and services which the Company provides. They may also use information about your visits to a Company website and other websites to target advertisements for goods or services. Your anonymous information is collected through a pixel tag, a standard technology used at most major consumer websites. This technology does not require the use or collection of any personally identifiable information such as your name or email address.

Children

We do not intend to collect any personal information from children under the age of eighteen. If a parent or guardian of a child who has provided us with such personal information would like the information deleted from our records, he or she should contact us at the email address or telephone number listed at the bottom of this Policy. We will then delete the child's personal information from our files.

If we become aware that personally identifiable information regarding a child under the age of 18 has been collected at the site, we will use such information for the sole purpose of contacting a parent or guardian of the child to obtain verifiable parental consent. If we cannot obtain consent after a reasonable period of time, or if when contacted, a parent or guardian requests that we do not use or maintain such information, we will make reasonable efforts to delete it from our records. Upon request by a parent or guardian, the Company will provide a description of the specific types of personal information collected from a child who is under the age of 18.

Cookies and IP Addresses

A cookie is a piece of information stored in your hard drive containing information about you. The Company may place cookies on your hard drive to assist in site navigation and to personalize your experience on the Company site. If you want to disable those cookies, most internet browsers will allow you to delete cookies from your computer hard drive, prevent them from being stored, or signal a warning before a cookie is stored. Please refer to your browser instructions or "help" screen to learn more about these functions. If

you elect to block cookies, please note that you may not be able to take full advantage of the features and functions of the site.

We may use a vendor's services to help the Company measure the effectiveness of advertising and to learn about how visitors to our websites use them. To obtain accurate measurements, we may use web beacons and cookies provided by a vendor on our websites. The type of information we would collect would include the specific website and pages visited, and information about transactions made. We may use such data to conduct targeted marketing programs or to determine the nature of our customers and the types of products or services that each customer finds most attractive.

We may use your IP address to help diagnose problems with our servers and to administer our website. Your IP address may also be used to gather broad demographic data and to recognize customer traffic patterns and site usage.

Links to other Websites

From time to time, the Company may have a link to other websites of corporate and marketing partners or for your convenience. Please check the privacy policies of such other websites which may vary from this one.

We have no responsibility or liability whatsoever for the content, actions or policies of third party websites. The inclusion of third party websites on our site in no way constitutes an endorsement of such websites' content, actions or policies.

Surveys and Contests

The Company website may request personal information from you via an electronic entry form for purposes of your participation in sweepstakes, contests or surveys. If you choose to provide the personal information requested, we will use that personal information to administer your participation in the relevant sweepstake, contest or survey and in the other ways indicated in this Policy.

Security

The Company has adopted reasonable technical and organizational security measures to prevent unauthorized or unlawful access to or accidental loss of or destruction of your personal information. Not all personal information collected on this website will be retained. All personal information that is retained is encrypted and all systems linked to the internet are equipped with firewalls and tested regularly to provide a high level of

security.

We may retain your personal information at a colocation center in Royal Oaks, Michigan, USA or we may send it to the Company's Detroit or Los Angeles offices, but we will assure the security of your personal information in all of our facilities.
